DESCRIPTION

Kingfisher ADMIX MORTAR PLASTICISER is a concentrated liquid air entraining plasticiser, which improves workability and freeze/thaw resistance in bricklaying mortars conforming to BS 4887 Mortar Plasticisers.

BENEFITS.

- ***Improves trowelability and workability.***
- ***Provides resistance to freeze/thaw cycle down to Minus 2°C.***
- ***Chloride free and so reduces 'bleeding'.***

METHOD OF USE.

Dilute with clean water at 1 part Admix to 40 parts water and mix well into cement and aggregate..

LIMITATION of USE.

- ***Do not overdose.***
- ***Do not mix with other additives.***
- ***Do not use in structural concrete.***

PACKAGING

Kingfisher ADMIX is supplied in 5, 25 and 200 litre containers.

STORAGE/ SHELF LIFE.

Up to 2 years in unopened containers.

Store in original, unopened container at temperatures between +5°C and +30°C at all times.
PROTECT FROM FROST.
